Safety and Awareness at Pond

Providing a safe space for all God's Children has been a guiding principle for ministry here at Pond. That means offering welcome and a non-judgmental place for people to explore their spirituality. It also means working to ensure that those who attend worship are as physically safe as possible. We



salt the parking lot when it snows or is slick, we keep our eyes on significant weather, and while we wish we did not have too, we are thinking about how to protect those who attend our worship from violence.

While we know that there is no way to completely be protected from this, in conversation with our leadership, deacons and our insurance provider, we are being proactive by having our deacons lock the front doors 15 min after worship begins to prevent entry to the church without anyone knowing. If you have any questions or comments about this please feel free to reach out to Rev. Chad or leadership.

Finally, we recognize that harm can also come in the form of germs and viruses. While illness has not gotten to a level that needs our attention at this time, we are prepared to provide care and connection to our members in safe and appropriate ways if health officials declare an emergency. This is not something we hope to ever deal with, still our community seeks to be aware and prepared as best as possible.
