Pond's Return to In-Person Worship Team Report

After meetings, conversations, and planning the Return Team has a strategy when we are ready to gather again in the sanctuary for worship. The priority was to design and plan for an experience that was safe, meaningful and still offered a continued virtual component on the Zoom platform for those unable to be physically present.

While a plan has been designed and supplies/technology are being gathered, the team felt that the situation, with rising cases and the unknown of schools starting, called for time before we returned. They have recommended that we wait till after Labor Day to evaluate the status of the virus and then come together to set a return date. The church has set a Virtual Board Meeting for September 23 to readdress the situation.

In the meantime, the church and team will be preparing for that time when we can be back safely in our historic sanctuary and we will continue to offer outdoor worship opportunities with the Zoom worship on Sunday mornings.
